**Day 1 – 2: October 31 – November 1, 2017 Depart From Home**  
Today you board your flight and begin the adventure of a lifetime. Crossing the International Dateline, you skip a day ahead.

**Day 3: Thursday, November 2, 2017 Cairns, Australia - Tour Begins**  
Your tour opens in Cairns, the tropical gateway to one of the world's most spectacular natural attractions and a World Heritage site – the Great Barrier Reef. Established as a marine park in 1975, the reef is a haven for thousands of species of sea life, as well as turtles and birds. (D)

**Day 4: Friday, November 3, 2017 Great Barrier Reef Board a high speed catamaran for an exciting excursion** to the Great Barrier Reef. This is an immense series of 2,800 coral reefs which are home to amazingly diverse marine life. Explore the reef from your base on Green Island. Enjoy a glass bottom boat ride, stroll the island walking trails, relax on the beaches, snorkel or just watch the fish and sea turtles swim past from the pier. For a more adventurous encounter with the reef, optional scuba diving and an outer reef tour are also available. Whichever way you choose, you'll see some of the world's most fascinating marine and plant life. (B, L)

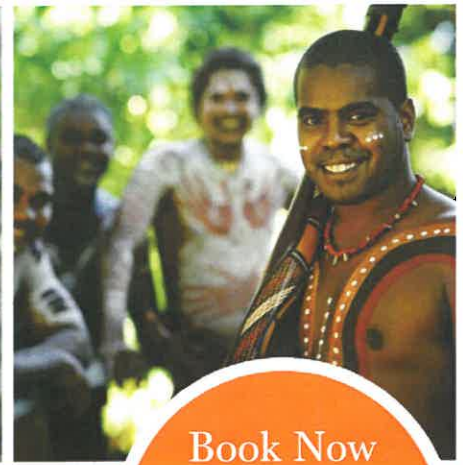
**Day 5: Saturday, November 4, 2017 Cairns** Come to know the history of Australia's original inhabitants at the Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Center. Here you'll see traditional dances, learn how to play a didgeridoo or even throw a boomerang. Browse the renowned art gallery and visit the interpretation center which houses a collection of interesting artifacts. At Hartley's Croc Farm, get up close and personal with crocodiles in their natural habitat! Boardwalks take you on a path of adventure through rainforests and woodlands, home to birds, reptiles and wallabies. While visiting you also **have the chance to meet some of the local koalas and have a private talk with a wildlife naturalist** to learn more about these cuddly creatures. Take an exciting cruise on the lagoon and watch for crocodiles before enjoying a delicious Aussie barbecue. (B, D)

**Day 6: Sunday, November 5, 2017 Cairns - Sydney** Your morning is at leisure. Make your own adventure or simply relax and take in the tropical atmosphere. Later today, fly to the bustling city of Sydney. (B)

**Day 7: Monday, November 6, 2017 Sydney** This morning, **see where the original English colonists first settled in 1788** during a city tour of Sydney. Highlights of your tour include Kings Cross, the Harbour Bridge, Chinatown, the Rocks, Circular Quay, the Botanic Gardens and the fashionable suburb of Paddington. Discover one of the world's most fascinating architectural sights as you **take a guided tour of the Sydney Opera House**, poised majestically on Sydney Harbour. Next, learn how raw opals mined from the depths of the Earth are transformed into beautiful works of art at the National Opal Centre. The evening is free to explore Sydney at your leisure...the opportunities are endless! (B)

**Day 8: Tuesday, November 7, 2017 Sydney** Take hold of the exciting city of Sydney during a day of independent exploration. Your Tour Manager will be on hand to offer suggestions. **Day 10: Thursday, November 9, 2017 Christchurch** Enjoy some leisure time to explore Christchurch on your own. You may wish to visit the International Antarctic Centre to learn about the 7th continent, or simply relax and enjoy what the city has to offer. (B)

**Day 11: Friday, November 10, 2017 Christchurch - Mt. Cook Region - Queenstown** Traverse the spectacular countryside to New Zealand’s most famous national park, Mount Cook. Mt. Cook is one of the most impressive mountains in the world. En route, visit a Canterbury farmyard for a fantastic opportunity to learn how a New Zealand family farm operates. You may even catch a sheep shearing demonstration. **Continue to Queenstown** and enjoy a stop at a local fruit stand to gain an inside look at the produce of New Zealand. This evening, take in the city of Queenstown from above and **soak in the breathtaking views during a gondola ride to dinner at the Skyline Restaurant** overlooking Queenstown, Lake Wakatipu and the Remarkable Mountains. **Day 12: Saturday, November 11, 2017 Queenstown - Milford Sound - Queenstown** En route to Milford Sound, enjoy the rugged grandeur of the Hollyford Valley. You’ll travel through ancient beech forest via the Homer Tunnel. **During a cruise of the breathtakingly beautiful Milford Sound** you will see why this fjord is one of the most visited sights on the South Island. With rock faces that rise nearly 4,000 feet on either side, the scenery will take your breath away. Following your cruise, you return to Queenstown. You may choose to return via a

short optional flight (weather permitting) for spectacular views of New Zealand’s Southern Alps. (B, L)

**Day 13: Sunday, November 12, 2017 Queenstown** Today Queenstown offers up several options to enhance your tour. Shop or people-watch in the village; enjoy an optional and exhilarating jet boat ride on the Shotover River; or join the optional "Journey through Middle Earth" tour which takes you through the majestic Remarkable Mountains and the breathtaking Queenstown countryside showcasing many of the spots where *The Lord of the Rings* movies were filmed.
