

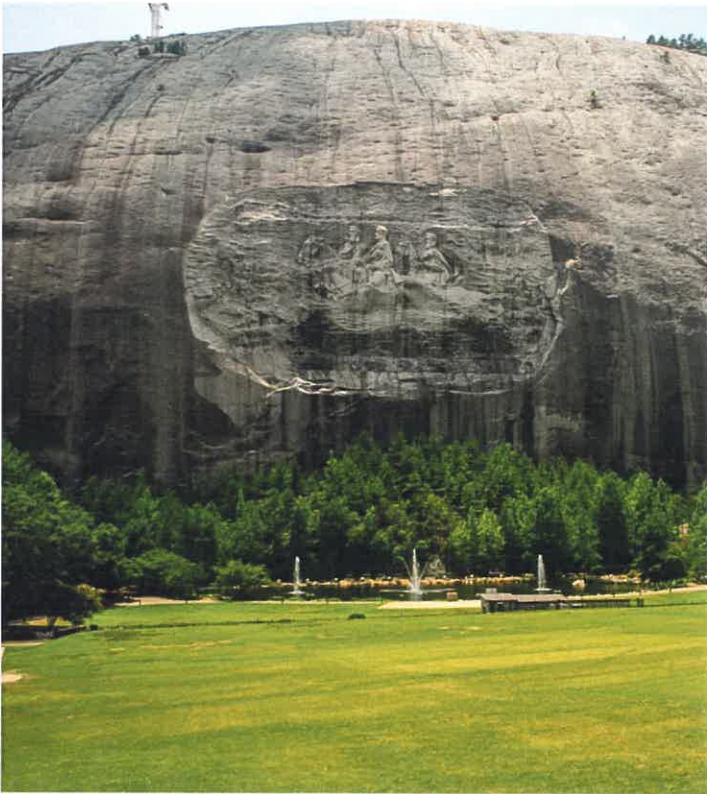

Days 1 – 3 Grand Hyatt Atlanta Buckhead, Atlanta, Georgia
Days 4 – 6 The Edgewater Hotel, Gatlinburg, Tennessee
Days 7, 8 Aloft Asheville Downtown, Asheville, North Carolina
On some dates alternate hotels may be used.

Day 1: Wednesday, October 17, 2018 Atlanta, Georgia - Tour Begins Experience warm southern hospitality in America's southeast. Come to know its rich history and deep traditions on this tour highlighted by stays in Atlanta, Gatlinburg and Asheville. Arrive in Atlanta today for your 3-night stay.

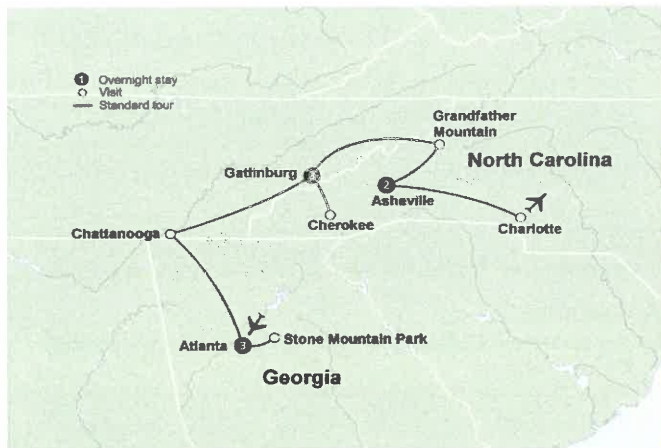
Day 2: Thursday, October 18, 2018 Atlanta Start your day off with a city tour of Atlanta. During the city tour you will visit the CNN Center and participate in an Inside CNN Studios tour. You'll also visit Coca Cola World and taste the many flavors of Coke from all over the world. Tonight, join your fellow travelers at a local restaurant for a welcome dinner. *(B, D)*

Day 3: Friday, October 19, 2018 Atlanta - Stone Mountain Park - Atlanta Today we travel outside of the city to Stone Mountain Park and enjoy the summit skyride. This high speed Swiss cable car provides a stunning view of the Confederate Memorial Carving as it transports guests more than 825 feet above ground to the top of Stone Mountain. At the top, experience amazing views of the Atlanta skyline, the Appalachian Mountains and more up to 60 miles away. This afternoon **the choice is yours** - enjoy a visit to the moving Center for Civil and Human Rights or visit the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library and Museum. Tonight, dinner is on your own with time to explore Atlanta by night. *(B)*

Day 4: Saturday, October 20, 2018 Atlanta - Chatanooga, Tennessee - Gatlinburg This morning, travel to Chattanooga and view the Chatanooga Choo Choo which currently stands as a motel. Afterward, enjoy some free time to explore Chattanooga and have lunch before continuing on to Gatlinburg. Tonight, be entertained by Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede and dinner/show. *(B, D)*

Day 5: Sunday, October 21, 2018 Gatlinburg - Dollywood - Gatlinburg Travel to Pigeon Forge for an included visit to Dolly Parton's theme park - Dollywood! In addition to standard amusement park thrill rides, Dollywood features traditional crafts and music of the Smoky Mountains area. Dollywood is organized into ten themed areas. The Showstreet, Rivertown Junction, Craftsmen's Valley, Village, Country Fair, Timber Canyon, and Jukebox Junction areas reflect the historical eras and culture of east Tennessee, while the Owens Farm and Adventures in Imagination areas explore Dolly Parton's life and imagination. Many attractions focus on the history and culture of the southern Appalachian region. Upon arrival back in Gatlinburg, enjoy a visit to Sugarland's Distillery to taste some moonshine. Tonight you are free to explore Gatlinburg on your own. *(B)*

Day 6: Monday, October 22, 2018 Gatlinburg - Cherokee, North Carolina - Gatlinburg Today you will get to

experience one of the most beautiful and one of the oldest places on earth- Great Smoky Mountains National Park, the most visited national park in the U.S. It is a UNESCO World Heritage site with one of the most diverse ecosystems on earth. In Cherokee, visit the Oconaluftee Visitors Center. This afternoon enjoy a ride on the Smoky Mountain Railroad. Take a ride alongside the beautiful Nantahala River on the Nantahala Gorge Excursion departing from Bryson City; this 4.5 hour excursion carries you 44 miles to the Nantahala Gorge and back again. (B)

Day 7: Tuesday, October 23, 2018 Gatlinburg - Grandfather Mountain, North Carolina - Asheville We leave Gatlinburg today for the state of North Carolina. Travel to Grandfather Mountain and then south on the Blue Ridge Parkway toward Asheville. Upon arrival, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure for independent exploration. (B)

Day 8: Wednesday, October 24, 2018 Asheville Begin your morning with a glass blowing demonstration at Lexington Glassworks, Back in 1895, George Vanderbilt II decided to build himself "a little mountain escape" in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. The result was the impressive Biltmore Estate. Today you will tour the mansion and the grounds. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 9: Thursday, October 25, 2018 Asheville - Charlotte - Tour Ends Today your tour comes to an end. Travel to Charlotte for your afternoon flight home. (B)
