

Mission Oaks Preschool Frequently Asked Questions 2023-2024

Where is the Mission Oaks Preschool held?

4641 Marconi Ave. (Corner of Mission and Marconi Ave.), in the north wing of the Lutheran Church of Our Redeemer facilities.

Is Mission Oaks Preschool a faith-based program?

No. Although held at a church, our preschool is not a faith-based program.

What times and days are the Preschool Programs?

The Mission Oaks Preschool closely follows the same school schedule as the San Juan Unified School District. However, the Preschool will not close for Teacher Work Days or Staff Development days.

- · The Kare Bears program meets on Monday, Wednesday & Friday from 9am 12pm
- · The Teddy Bears program meets on Tuesday & Thursday from 9am 12pm

The school year begins on August 14, 2023 and ends on May 29, 2024

How much is monthly tuition?

Kare Bears Program: \$230 Teddy Bears Program: \$180

Will the cost for August be different because it is not a full month?

Yes. Upon enrollment, you will pay \$90 for Teddy Bears or \$115 for Kare Bears.

Who gets priority registration?

- · Current school year students
- · Siblings of current school year students
- · Residents of Mission Oaks Recreation and Park District
- · June & July 2023 summer students

What are the age requirements?

Teddy Bears – child must be 3 years old by September 1, 2023 Kare Bears – child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2023

Do I need to submit a birth certificate for my child?

Yes

Do I need to submit immunization records for my child?

No

Does my child need to be toilet trained?

All children MUST be toilet trained. Children may not wear diapers or pull-ups to school.

Is the Mission Oaks Preschool Licensed?

No, we are a county facility program and are not required to be licensed.

How/where do I pay for preschool?

We request monthly payments to be made by the 1st day of the month. If payment is not made by the 5th day of the month, then a 10% late fee will be assessed. If payment is not made by the 10th day of the month, the child will be removed from the program, after which the child's space may be filled from a waiting list.

Does the Mission Oaks Preschool go on field trips?

Yes, the preschool averages one field trip per month for the children's enjoyment and enrichment. To make these field trips possible, we will need parent assistance in driving and supervising the children.

Am I responsible to provide snack for the entire class?

No, you must provide individual snack for your child each school day. Snacks with nuts are not permitted at preschool.

Are there any pricing discounts?

What should my child bring to preschool?

- · A water bottle with their name on it
- · Snack (no nuts permitted)
- · Backpack or bag

Please apply sunscreen on your child before arriving to preschool each day.

What is the behavior policy?

After three behavior reports, a participant will be removed from the program. Incidents involving violence will lead to immediate removal from the program at the discretion of the supervisor of the preschool program.

What is the sick policy?

Any participants with Coronavirus, lice, chicken pox, the flu or any other contagious disease are not allowed at the preschool site and will be sent home. They may only return with a written note of clearance from their doctor. A negative Covid test may be substituted for a doctor's note in the situation that the participant was experiencing Covid symptoms or was quarantined due to Covid reasons.
