

# Fortnite Tournament Information

## 1) Equipment

- a. Console:
  - i) All games will be played on xBox One, Playstation 4, mobile, PC, or Nintendo Switch.
- b. Equipment:
  - i) Due to these activities being performed remotely, each participant must provide their own equipment. Internet access is required.

## 2) Registration Information

Registration Period: February 8<sup>th</sup> – March 19<sup>th</sup>

Entry Fee: \$10

Communication will primarily be through email and Discord.

- i) Updated standings will be communicated on Monday 4/5 via email and Discord.

You must be 18 years of age or younger to participate. This tournament is open to residents and non-residents.

Open to ages 12-18 years old

There will be a minimum of 8 participants and a maximum of 20.

## 3) Tournament Information

- . Round 1 Start Date: March 23<sup>rd</sup>
- a. Round 2 Start Date: March 30<sup>th</sup>
- b. Tournament Format:
  - i) There is no head-to-head competition in this tournament. Players will compete to get the best score overall. The goal is to have the highest score at the end of the second round.
- c. Location of Play: Each individual will play at their place of residence, using their own setup.
- d. Schedule:
  - i) Round 1:
    - (1) Starts Tuesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> (3/23), at 8:00am and will end Sunday, March 28<sup>th</sup> (3/28) at 9:59pm.
    - ii) No tournament play on Monday, March 29 (3/29). This day will be used to tally the results from the first round and communicate results.
  - iii) Round 2:

- (1) Starts Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> (3/30), at 8:00am and will end Sunday, April 4<sup>th</sup> (4/4) at 9:59pm.
- iv) Final results will be posted on Monday (4/5) after the second round.
- v) You will only be allowed to submit three games from matches played within each round window. Your results **MUST BE** reported prior to the end of each round.

#### 4) Rules of Play

. Games must be Battle Royale - Solos/Duos only. Games played in Squads will not count. Games played in any limited time mode will not count (Fortnitemares, Doomsday, etc.) -- please only submit results from **normal gameplay**.

a. Players will queue into random public lobbies through the game and play out their matches. NO custom/creative lobbies allowed. Any manipulation of lobbies will result in a forfeit and disqualification.

b. Once you have been eliminated or won the match, you will need to immediately capture an image of the result screen if you wish to use it as one of your three submissions for a round.

c. That image can be saved until you are ready to submit your final scores and all three pictures.

d. Quitting games is allowed if you choose to do so in order to earn points before the cutoff window (11:59pm) or in order to reset and enter the next match

#### 5) Scoring & Score Reporting

. Each participant will send an email or Discord message containing the following information:

- i) your name (real and username - please use the one that was submitted on the registration)
  - ii) whether each game was solo or duo
  - iii) where you finished in each
  - iv) how many eliminations in each.
- (1) In this email/message, please *include pictures of each of the three matches you wish to submit for that round*. The three images should each include the place which you finished and your eliminations (the match stats screen).

a. During each round window, players will play as many matches as they wish. After every match, a picture should be taken of your results in case you wish to send in that score. You will only be submitting **three** finishes *per round*. These results **MUST BE** reported prior to the end of each round.

b. At the end of each round, the scores will be tallied for all participants. This will be done for you; please only send in the results.

- (1) *These must be sent with pictures to be considered.*

- c. Scoring will be based on the following:
- i) 10 points for a victory
  - ii) 1 point per elimination
  - iii) Solos:
    - (1) Finishing 2-5: 7 points
    - (2) Finishing 6-15: 5 points
    - (3) Finishing 16-25: 3 points
  - iv) Duos:
    - (1) Finishing 2-5: 7 points
    - (2) Finishing 6-10: 5 points
    - (3) Finishing 11-15: 3 points
  - v) In the event of a tie, we will go through the following tiebreakers
    - (1) Number of victories
    - (2) Average elimination per game
    - (3) Average placement per game
    - (4) Coin flip

## 6) Eligibility.

### Player Code of Conduct

- a. **Offensive expression.** Avoid expressing ourselves in an offensive manner toward other players or their actions in the game, regardless of whether they are opponents or teammates.
- b. **Offensive language.** Avoid using language, nicknames or other expressions that insult another player's gender, gender identity, origin, physical ability, sexual orientation, religion or age.
- c. **Team dynamic.** Always support your team, communicating positively and with respect.
- d. **Violent language.** Avoid using language or actions that refer to sexual violence or other violence.
- e. **Violent actions.** Avoid acting in a threatening or violent manner.
- f. **Cheating.** Avoid cheating or hacking.
- g. **Private information.** Avoid sharing our account information or any other private information that could put ourselves or our peers at risk.
- h. **Harassment.** You may not harass other players, team members, or other associated parties.
- i. **Sexual Harassment.** You may not sexually harass other players, team members or other associated parties. There is zero tolerance for any sexual threats or coercion or the promise of advantages in exchange for sexual favors.
- j. **Discrimination and Denigration.** You may not offend the dignity or integrity of a country, private person, or group of people through contemptuous, discriminatory, or denigratory words or actions on account of race, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, ability status, gender identity, language, religion, political opinion or any other opinion, sexual orientation, or any other reason.
